Registration is due by Thursday, September 27th. Please note if you register after that day you will not be guaranteed a T-shirt.

Completed Registration Forms should be returned to OLP.

Registration Fee: The registration fee is \$20 per person.

Children registered in the Walk for Education will receive a Walk for Education t-shirt.

Prizes: The class with the highest participation rate in the Walk for Education will receive a pizza party and two dress down days! The class with the 2nd highest participation rate will also receive a prize (i.e., dress down day)!
